Dear BLM managers,

We are all busy, but I am taking time away from my family and life to write you concerning the Clear Creek Management Plan and the looming deadline for public input.

From a citizen point of view, I want to let the BLM know that there has not been an adequate number of meetings, time for education, and feedback regarding the Clear Creek Management Plan. This is a complex plan and more time is needed. I think we all will agree that this plan will have long lasting economic, ecological, social, and recreational implications. Public input and consideration of this input, by land managers and policy makers, is critical for a good outcome.

I strongly urge you and your fellow decision makers to extend the deadline for education, and public comment by at least another 90 days. Then, please take the time to seriously listen and consider the input given by those directly involved and affected.

Far too often, I have seen situations like this, where decisions have been made ahead of time, and managers have turned a deaf ear to input from those affected. The result often leads to poor management policies that severely hurt local economies and eliminate recreation opportunities all in the name of protecting the environment.

Well... I know the environment, local economy, and public can all be protected while still allowing well managed and responsible recreation and access. Proposals that flat out ban access and recreation are almost always short sighted and do not provide the best solution. I am extremely concerned that this is happening with the Clear Creek Management Plan.

Please also consider... When families recreate together they are building quality and healthy relationships. This time allows parents time to teach their children to care about and appreciate nature, wildlife, and the outdoors. I know... I was raised that way. My father taught my brother and myself about geology while we camped around California and explored many of the public lands on our OHVs. At the same time, my mother... books in hand... taught us about the creatures that we would see. Both my brother and I grew up appreciating the environment and also enjoy recreating in it. I am raising a family now and want my kids to be able to have many of the experiences that I have had. Are we to protect the environment to the point that the next generation will only know it from the video games that they play?

Too many places are closing for non-scientific ideological reasons... often due to pressure from so called environmental groups. I also realize that a lack of management resources has been a major factor. Never-the-less, the continued closing of recreational areas is a crime that is being perpetrated against the public. It is a fact that the public has been rapidly loosing areas to recreate on public lands. This continues even while the number of people recreating has been increasing. This has lead to heavier and heavier use at the few areas open to multi-use recreation. This is bad policy and will lead to many future management issues. Instead, the solution should be to open more areas and more trails to spread out the use and thus the impact.

Lets find a responsible way to manage Clear Creek and keep it open to OHV, hunting, target shooting, camping, etc... Again... think out of the box... expand the trail network... spread out the use and impact!

Regardless as to whether or not you agree with my point of view on recreation... please do the right thing and extend the comment period for the Clear Creek Management Area plan. Please hold more meetings (at times when working people can actually attend... such as later at night or on weekends). Then... step back and listen to what the local residents and those directly affected recommend!!!!!!

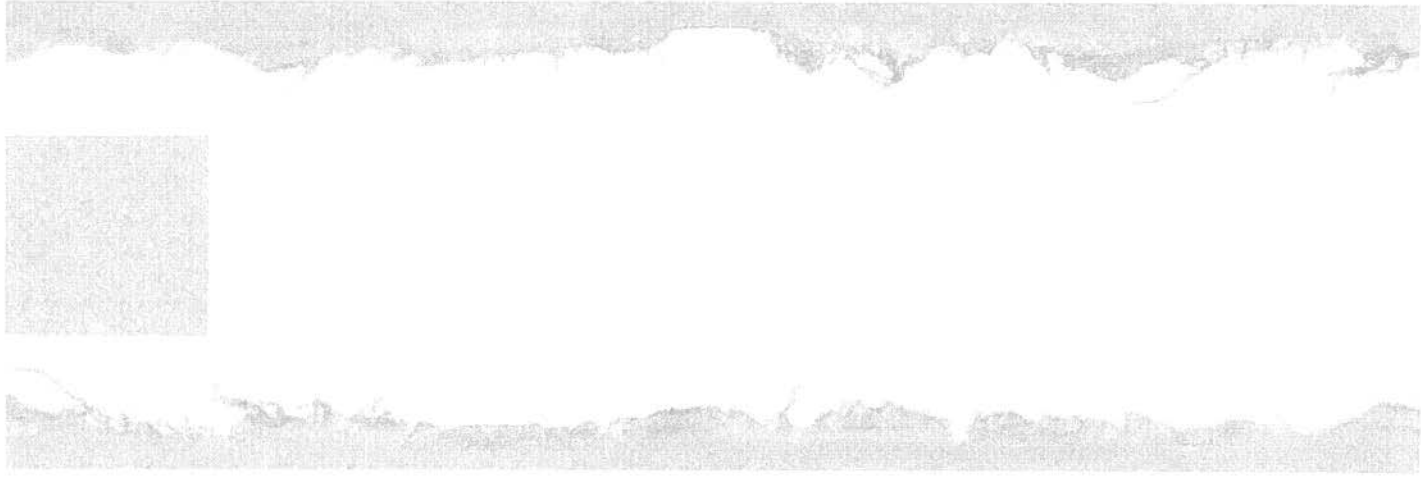

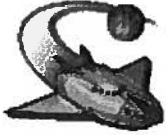
