CEQ regulation 1508.14 Human Environment in part reads "When an environmental impact statement is prepared and economic or social and natural or physical environmental effects are interrelated, then the environmental impact statement will discuss all of these effects on the human environment."

CEQ regulation 1500.1 (b) reads in part "NEPA procedures must insure that environmental information is available to public officials and citizens before decisions are made and before actions are taken."

#### **Discussion**

While the BLM, with the cooperation of the EPA, has shown an alleged increased cancer risk while recreating at CCMA over a lifetime, they have failed to provide any context with other quantitative risks in a persons lifetime.

#### **Recommendation**

Add the attached document, to add context and balance to the EIS, in order to inform the reader of the magnitude of risks associated with recreation at CCMA.
