Subject: EPA's Findings Regarding Wet/Dry Weather Conditions

Discussion: The EPA report findings indicated the same amount of dust was created in both wet and dry conditions by each particular user group. This also was a statement made by an EPA official at the public comment meeting in Santa Clara on May 8, 2008.

This is absolutely impossible. Dust cannot be created in typical wet conditions such as pooled water (puddles), snow or moist/muddy conditions. The BLM should have rejected the EPA's report immediately upon learning of the results released by the EPA where they claim to have the same level of dust in the air in both dry and wet conditions.

Recommendation: Reject the EPA's report on the Asbestos Exposure and Human Health Risk Assessment for CCMA and exclude **ALL** references to their report in the BLM's DEIS for CCMA. Reopen CCMA immediately until a more accurate report can be submitted to the BLM showing realistic numbers and data that can prove without a doubt that there is health risks associated with recreating at CCMA.
