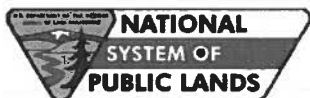

My name is Anthony Lane. I am here as a concerned citizen and representing the Tule Gem Club as one of the youngest adult members. I would like to voice my concerns over the permanent closing of Clear Creek Management Area.

I am disappointed in the proposed closing of public lands. As a child, I have fond memories of playing and hiking in areas similar to Clear Creek. Those experiences engaged me as an adult to share them with my children. However, more and more of these lands are being closed to access for future generations to enjoy.

I completely understand the health risks associated with the Clear Creek Management Area. I do agree that safety is an important issue and some resolution needs to be accomplished in this matter. But, shutting off access to public lands is an extreme measure. I support application of an alternate action that would allow access in a limited manner keeping safety and access as viable solutions. I support the application proposed under Alternative B.

Alternative B would maintain the Clear Creek Management Area's current multiple use opportunities and would enforce limited annual visitor use days, seasonal use restrictions, but would maintain public health and safety.

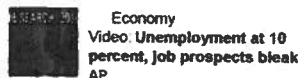
